Description: 45North Presenters teach about healthy relationships and the importance of avoiding sexual risks using fun and interactive lessons in schools, churches, and other venues.


Reports To: Community Engagement Director or Education Coordinator

- Research and understand 45North topics to teach effectively in a variety of venues.
- Coordinate with school administrators, church leaders, and other key community personnel regarding schedules, special needs, evaluations, etc.
- Enforce applicable rules and standards of presentation venue.
- Assist with training new 45North Presenters as needed.
- Commute within a 40-mile radius of ZoeCare's office.
- Provide summary reports to Community Engagement Director or Education Coordinator.
- Other duties as assigned.
