Here are a few updates, numbers from last year, and a look at ZoeCare’s massive 2026 expansion. 2026 is going to be a truly exciting year as we watch God move.

Some snippets...

Body Literacy in the Community. ZoeCare offers a workshop called Period Genius for mothers and daughters to learn about puberty and how to empower young women from a Christian worldview.

“Me and my mom went on a trip to Salt Lake City to hang out with my older sister and baby nephew. During this trip, I was a lot more quiet and secluded. This confused my mom a lot because I normally would be super excited to see them. When my mom voiced her concerns, I immediately checked my FEMM app...and discovered that I was just in my luteal phase and needed some alone time. The way that Becca articulates this course, helping me and other teenage girls understand their bodies better, is so amazing.”

One of our mentees describes his recent fatherhood journey as “finding my way back.” Though in a challenging relationship with the mother of his children, he has found his way back to being a dad and back to church. Because of the invitation from his ZoeCare mentor, he is attending church and finding healing. Now, no matter how the circumstances turn out with the mother of his children, he sees a way forward. He is finding his way back.

45North in the Schools. In 2025, ZoeCare’s team of presenters taught relationship training, sex education, and body literacy in nine classrooms for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades at Three Forks Middle School, three classrooms for 9th-12th grades at Three Forks High School, two classrooms for 7th and 8th grades at Manhattan Christian School, two classrooms for 7th and 8th grades at Gallatin Gateway Middle School, one classroom for 10th grade at Mt. Ellis Academy, and one presentation to 65 women at Delta Gamma sorority at MSU.

SETTING ZOECARE APART

In 2025, ZoeCare began working diligently toward accreditation with the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care, Inc. (AAAHC). This important step reflects our deep commitment to clinical excellence, operational integrity, and faithful stewardship of the resources entrusted to us. Once achieved, this distinction will place ZoeCare among the top 10% of ambulatory clinics nationwide for excellence, consistency, and quality of care — a milestone made possible through your partnership. AAAHC is the nation’s leading third-party accreditation organization that surveys hospitals, surgical centers, and smaller clinics like ours. There are a mere 24 accredited entities in Montana, and ZoeCare is hoping in 2026 to become number 25.

Achieving accreditation strengthens every aspect of our work — from patient services and emergency preparedness to infection control, safety standards, HIPAA compliance, and the qualifications of our staff and volunteers.

More than a credential, accreditation sends a clear message to our community — to both our champions and our critics — that ZoeCare operates among an elite group of trusted clinics committed to providing safe, consistent, and excellent care to every patient we serve. 




